2021 will go down as a special year, marked by severe weather instability. The general state of the vineyard was difficult to maintain, and it was only through constant effort and increased vigilance that we were able to preserve all the vineyard's qualities. The 2021 vintage is quite late, but the health of the berries is very good, although they are smaller than in previous years, their sugar content is rema quable, and the cool nights have enabled us to maintain high malic acid levels and good phenolic ripeness.

WINEMAKING

Grenache and Syrah grapes are traditionally vinified in small, temperature-controlled concrete vats. To optimize the wine's fruitiness and suppleness, extraction is gentle, with rapid pumping-over carried out daily at the start of fermentation.

AGEING

Aged in concrete vats to preserve red fruit and garrigue aromas.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE Bright red color with violet nuances.

Complex nose with aromas of blackberries, violets and smoky notes. Well-balanced, generous and supple on the palate. Strong fruity character. Spicy, juicy finish.
